#### **ELIGIBILITY**

- \* Scholarships and awards are open to those cadets that are in the Manitoba Royal Canadian Air Cadet program on September 15, who are entering or pursuing their post-secondary education such as university, college, flight training or any other vocational training.
- \* Scholarships and awards are also open to past cadets who aged out at age 19 between August 21, 2023 and September 16, 2024.
- \* Scholarships and awards are awarded on the basis of scholastic achievement, outstanding performance as an Air Cadet, community involvement and a donor's specific requirements.
- \* A cadet will be limited to one scholarship, or one award as noted above. A cadet may apply in successive years but will not be eligible to win two scholarships or awards.

### **PROCESS**

- \* An appointed selection board will consider all eligible candidates. The Chairperson of the Honours and Awards Committee will declare the name of the recipient of the award, and a cheque will be presented to the recipient or their institution of choice, when all requirements have been satisfied. Following selection, the recipient may be requested to provide a photograph or digital image (in uniform) for purposes of publicity.
- \* An award will not be finalized until confirmation of proof of acceptance and registration at the selected facility has been received. It should be noted that proof is not required at the time of application, but that it will be required from the selected recipients before awarding of the scholarship.

## REQUIRED INFORMATION

- \* A fully completed application form and supporting documents to be submitted by 2024 September 15. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- \* As well, the following are required to complete the application process:
  - A narrative from the applicant providing an outline of career goals and objectives (approximately 300 words), OR, a 3-5 minute video by the applicant, expressing the same.

- A letter of recommendation from the Squadron Commanding Officer; PLUS
- A letter of support from the Chairperson of the Squadron Sponsoring Committee; PLUS
- Another recommendation letter i.e. School Principal, Department Head, Counsellor, Flight Instructor, Employer;
- A copy of the most recent Transcript of Marks from either high school, post-secondary institution, or flight school.
